To inculcate in students respect for their dignity and rights of others.

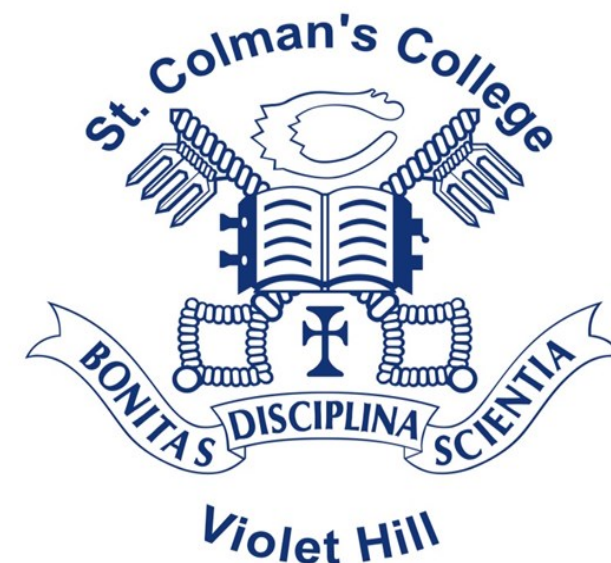
To create warm and positive relationships between students, staff and all members of the College community.
